WESTBEECH ROAD & BUS STOPS

Due to complaints from residents and Parish Council regarding the ongoing problems with vehicles parking in Westbeech Road and the Bus Stops on 06/07/2007 at 07.30hrs PC Hossack and PCSO Clifton (in absence of PCSO Street) carried out parking observations with the intention of issuing Fixed Penalty Notices. They also checked drivers using their mobile phones whilst driving, and seat belt checks, however, the parking was the main focus of their presence.

The police have suggested a solution to the parking problems on Westbeech Road would be to install a lay by from the restrictions on the playing fields side to just before the bend.

To report that: details including registrations, names and addresses were taken and these drivers were spoken to and strongly advised of their parking, however, no actual parking offences were committed on that day. Patrols updated PCSO Streets action plan with all the names and above details. PCSO's will continue to monitor this situation.
