This may stem from the several local boys being dealt with for the damage at the Eel Keepers Cottage, and the theft of the mince pies.***
- 2. Priority crime is excellent, with only 1 reported theft from motor vehicle, and 1 damage to m/v. I would ask for vigilance still, as a dark blue Nissan Micra, appears to be active around the area, targeting vehicles which have property on view***
- 3. There were two reported road traffic collisions. One on the Wolverhampton Rd, the other again at the top of the Westbeech Rd***
