87/10 A Special meeting was called to address vehicle access to Pattingham Playing fields following the installation of the Multi Use Games Area.

Several suggestions were made:

- Access from Westbeech Road would require planning permission.
- To access down the slope onto the football pitch - this was felt too steep for normal vehicle use.
- Access by the changing rooms, again the access is on a slope which would limit vehicles
- Installation of a gate from the front village hall car park.

Cllr Roberts raised concerns from the parents of the toddler group at the possible use of access via the children's play area.

Following lengthy discussion the District Council agreed that installing a wooden gate on the front car park would be the favourable option. This will mean a section of hedge will be removed. The gate will only be used for events held on the playing fields i.e. church fete, Bells run etc.

Assurances were made that the grass cutting contractors would continue to use the gate on Patshull Road.
